NEXT MEETING THURSDAY, APRIL 6TH

Dwayne Williams, our April presenter, was an Army helicopter gunship pilot in South Vietnam and then for 2 years an instructor pilot at Fort Wolters, Texas until 1969. He supported oil operations in the Gulf of Mexico for PHI until 1974. Until 1979 he was Chief Pilot, Advanced Flight Training for Bell Helicopter International in Isfahan, Iran.

After the shah fell, Dwayne transferred to Bell Helicopter Textron, served as experimental test pilot; and became Chief Pilot in 2000 before retiring in 2005. From there he went to Heritage Aviation, which was subsequently sold to MD Helicopters, where he was Chief Pilot and Director of Flight Operations until 2012. He is currently an associate

of AeroDynamix, Inc. serving as Flight Test Pilot for development of Night Vision Goggle-compatible cockpits.

Career highlights, too numerous to mention here, include accumulating more than 18,000 flight hours, being an FAA DER Flight Test Pilot since 1992, performing aerobatics in Bell 220/680 helicopters, and accomplishing first flights in numerous Bell aircraft, including the BA609. For more, read Dwayne's book, *Cottonfields to Copters*.

The subject of his presentation will be the battle of Easter Sunday, 1967, near Vinh Long and Soc Tran, Vietnam, augmented by information on Huey helicopters. Don't miss it.
