NEXT MEETING THURSDAY, JUNE 1ST

Erasmo Piñero is our presenter for the October meeting. After graduating from the University of Florida in Aerospace Engineering in 1984, he joined the Navy as a Naval Flight Officer. His Naval service included two aircraft carrier deployments, and gained him 800 hours of flying time in 12 types of aircraft. He subsequently became a Space Defense Specialist and served in the U.S. Naval Space Command.

He Joined Sikorsky Aircraft in 1991 and worked on several helicopters; next a stint at Pratt and Whitney doing ground testing of the X-35 engine. He then transferred to Lockheed Martin on the Joint Strike Fighter program, coordinating all engine and aircraft systems integration. After working at Bell Helicopter on the V-22, Erasmo became Chief Engineer at ATAC,

an "aggressor fighter" service company that trains US and allied fighter pilots.

Erasmo will describe the last Martin flying boat, the Martin P6M SeaMaster, covering the origins, design, developmental history, flight testing highlights, and demise of this large; but extremely elegant, flying boat. This aircraft was the last flying boat designed and built by the Glenn L. Martin Aircraft company before the company's diversion into space related work. This work was carried out before Martin's eventual merger with the industrial conglomerate American-Marietta Corp and aerospace giant Lockheed Aircraft Co.

Marc Liebman gave us a most interesting presentation on a Korean dogfight in which an American pilot in an F9F Panther shot down four of seven Russian MiG-15s that engaged him. The feat was kept top-secret until Russia released the details over 50 years later. Due to the brevity of that talk, he then provided a whole second program on the Grumman F4F Wildcat vs. the Mitsubishi A6M Zero during WWII. Thanks for the double-header, Marc.
